

- 1** Decorate three jars or containers, and label with "Save," "Spend," and "Share."
- 2** Kick things off with some starter money (coins, allowance, or chore earnings).
- 3** Talk about each jar's purpose:
 - **Save:** future goals (a toy or outing)
 - **Spend:** small treats or wants
 - **Share:** help others (gifts, community causes)
- 4** Practice dividing funds: When your child receives money, help them split it up (e.g., 50% Save, 40% Spend, 10% Share).
- 5** Track progress: Use a chart or stickers to mark savings milestones. **Celebrate** when a goal is reached!
